Statement from the North American Imams Fellow (NAIF)

The North American Imams Fellow (NAIF) expresses its deep sorrow and condemnation following the tragic shooting at the Islamic Center of San Diego.

We extend our heartfelt condolences to the families of the victims and pray for the safety, healing, and recovery of all those affected. No house of worship should ever become a place of fear, violence, or bloodshed.

We call upon law enforcement authorities to conduct a full and transparent investigation and to ensure that justice is carried out swiftly and fairly.

NAIF also calls for an end to the language of hatred, division, and dehumanization that continues to poison public discourse. Whether it comes from officials, activists, media voices, or religious figures, rhetoric that incites fear and hostility against communities must be rejected. The American public must stand united against hatred and refuse efforts to divide our nation through fear and polarization.

This is a time for national solidarity, moral responsibility, and the protection of every community's right to worship and live in peace.

We urge masjid and Muslim communities across the country to remain vigilant and proactive in protecting their congregations and institutions.
